

ANIMAL & STILL PROJECTS...What you need for 2018...

Project Books must be completed for all projects as set out in the sheets in front of your book and signed by non-parental advisor as completed.

Club requirements for projects may be more stringent for Club Honor Member status. Check w/ your advisor & your Club's By Laws.

Quality Assurance is required for **all MARKET & DAIRY PROJECTS**. See flyer & upcoming Newsletters for dates.

All Dog Projects must attend Skillathon. **You and Your Dog** is an optional judging opportunity at PJD. Watch Newsletter for details.

NO ANIMALS will be brought to Tag-In, except Steers in November.

SKILLATHON is mandatory for all animal projects, except llamas, cats and small animals. These projects are judged on **Project Judging Day**. Check upcoming newsletters for **2018 Skillathon** information.

Requirements for **State Fair** (if you are chosen to attend) are outlined on the Project Sheet included in your project book. Review these requirements to make sure you understand what each project requires (county/state).

PROJECT JUDGING DAY (PJD) is required for all Still Projects, llamas, cats, rodents & reptiles (Small Animals).

Members must attend Project Judging Day for at least 1 project if no animals projects are taken.

IMPORTANT CHANGE FOR FOOD PROJECTS...We're going back to the good old days where you will be required to bring a sample of a food/recipe/menu item that you have read about in your book and tried. **(NOTE: This is a county requirement and not one for the state fair.)** You will also need a food portfolio showing what you learned in your project. **(NOTE: This is a state fair requirement.)** You will also be expected to set a basic table setting. Dishes/silverware will be provided.
