_____ *Citizenship Washington Focus* @ Washington, D.C. (June 21-27) (2 recipients selected; for ages 14-19). Total Cost is \$1700... Your cost is \$570. The program enables 4-H members to learn more about our government, gain a better understanding of national problems and commit themselves to more responsible citizenship. Delegates will visit famous and historical places, meet other 4-H members, share 4-H experiences and ideas with youth from all over the country and meet your congressman/congresswoman. Cost is \$1300 and participant must pay a non-refundable \$200 deposit.

_____ *State Leadership Camp* @ 4-H Camp Ohio, Utica, June 1-5, 2022 - Cost is usually \$280 per person, but Nationwide Insurance and Farm Credit provides a scholarship amount toward this opportunity for participants. Your cost is generally \$60 but this information has yet to be confirmed for 2022. - 2 recipients selected; open to 4-H young men and women ages 15-18 (mature 14 year old members will be considered). The purpose of Leadership Camp is to provide personal growth, strength, leadership skills make new friends, fun and fellowship and to gain new ideas. Must provide own transportation.

_____ *4-H Sea Camp* @ Lake Erie 2022 Camp Dates: July 15-July 19- Final cost for Sea Camp 2022 is not yet confirmed, although it is expected to be roughly the same as planned for past years; no more than \$450. So, your cost will be approximately \$150. Through partnerships of Ohio State University Extension and organizations that offer aquatic education and water recreation, Ohio 4-H Sea Camp at Kelleys Island has offered hundreds of young people the opportunity to learn about aquatic science and experience a variety of recreational watersports on Lake Erie. Sea Camp is offered to youth ages 15-17 (age as of first day of camp). The mission of Ohio 4-H Sea Camp is to offer teenage youth an introduction to the Great Lakes through hands-on experiences in a variety of aquatic-based programs. Sea Camp will enable participants to experience Lake Erie-based activities and culture such as aquatic science, water recreation, and fishing. The program is a supervised, educational environment fostered by Ohio 4-H and The Ohio State University. OBJECTIVES OF OHIO 4-H SEA CAMP INCLUDE: Participants will gain an understanding of safety applied to watercraft, sun, and open water recreation. ;

Participants will explore a variety of potential career opportunities through learning from professionals in aquatic science, natural resources, and watersports.; Participants will gain lifelong skills fostered through educational and recreational water-based activities, while developing lasting friendships and comradery with peers.

_____ **Forestry Camp** @ FFA Camp Muskingum, Carroll County June 12-17 - Cost: \$375 - 2 recipients selected; must be at least 15 years old by June and completed the 8th grade. The student(s) attending will participate in classes covering tree identification, silviculture, ecology and forest products. Measure the size of standing trees and logs and determine their value. Special evening activities are planned throughout the week. Must provide own transportation. A portion of the trip is sponsored by Jefferson County Soil & Water Conservation District and the Jefferson County 4-H Committee.

_____ **Shooting Sports Camp** @ Camp Piedmont. The first week of June. Shooting Sports Camp gives campers the opportunity to choose one of four disciplines: archery, rifle, shotgun or air pistol in which to gain knowledge and practice in a safe environment. (More information and cost TBA)

_____ **Carving New Ideas** @ 4-H Camp Ohio - Late October/early November - 8-12th grade. This camping opportunity develops critical thinking through hands-on workshops including health, agriscience and STEM. More information and cost TBA. This is a weekend camp.

_____ **Making Xtreme Counselors Camp** @ the 4-H Center Columbus. This is open to camp counselors only. It supplements county training. It is interactive, covers specific core competencies each year, and brings together teens from multiple camps to share ideas. It is a great way for counselors to learn from someone different and to share ideas from songs and skits, to evening programs and facilitation skills! The speaker this year will be Tim Borton. **Dates: February 19-20**, Location: Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center, 2201 Fred Taylor Drive, Columbus, OH 43210; Cost: \$55; This year, it is an opportunity for counselors to receive up to 14 hours of training, which supplements county training. Jefferson County can send up to 15 counselors. If you are interested in this opportunity please apply, as the county committee can cost-share 2 youth but others can choose to pay the full \$55 and still attend with their friends. This is the only opportunity that can be attended more than one time, as the material changes each time. **YOU MAY NOT ARRIVE LATE OR LEAVE EARLY.**

_____ **Space Adventure Camp** @ Marietta College. 4-H Space Adventure Camp is for youth ages 11 to 13 and/or students who were 5th to 7th graders during this school year. You will have the opportunity to explore the world of flight and science as you build and test flying machines, conduct computer flight simulations, learn about the principles of aerodynamics and gain an overview of the development of the space flight program. The three action-packed days will take you through an exciting adventure in 'hands-on' learning including: building and flying hot air balloons, model rockets and other 'things that fly'; touring the universe within a planetarium; exploring the stars and planets; learning about an astronaut's life on a mission; computer flight simulation and space exploration; launching your model rocket; participating in a special graduation ceremony. There is often a waitlist for this camp. This camp is generally held mid-June and the cost will be close to \$300. More information will be provided as it becomes available.
