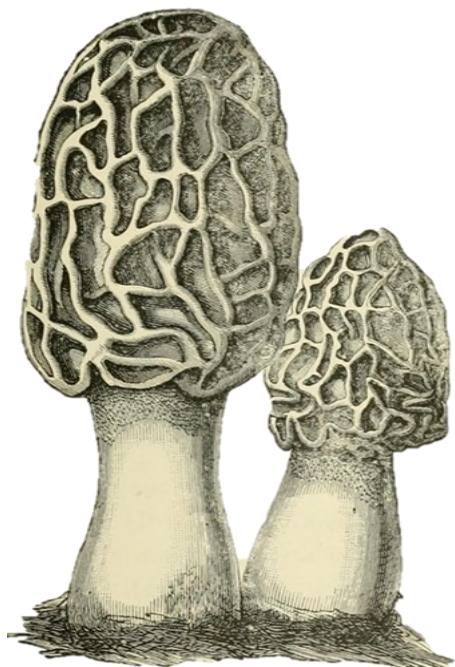


INTRODUCTION TO HUNTING MORELS AND OTHER EDIBLE MUSHROOMS
